



**Case based integration / integrated practice / integrated tutorials / synthesis in special themes, professional consolidation**

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As part of our commitment to the ongoing improvement of the credentialing process, The Alliance continuously reviews credentialing requirements to ensure that they are fair and objective for all credentialing applicants.

Since the introduction of case based integration / integrated practice / integrated tutorials / synthesis in special themes / professional consolidation as a **sub element** of one of the seven categories in the 2008 Credentialing Standards approved by The Alliance Board of Directors, both The Alliance and credentialing applicants have encountered many challenges in obtaining program information or reasonable courses that fulfill this content. Given that this sub element is relatively minor in the Professional Practice category, The Alliance has decided to remove it as required content.

Consequently, effective immediately the content requirement for case based integration / integrated practice / integrated tutorials / synthesis in special themes / professional consolidation has been removed from the list of required content for all applicants including those who are currently enrolled in the Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) program.

If we identified this as a gap in your Assessment Report, you are no longer required to take a course to fulfill it or provide additional information. For future applicants, this will not be included in the assessment as a required content.
