Credentialling Fee Increase

Effective **January 1, 2012** there will be a fee increase for services within the credentialling program.

The new fees are listed below:

Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR)	\$ 575	\$150
New File Review (Re-Assessment)	\$ 250	\$ 70
