

Credentialing Fee Increase

Effective January 1, 2009 there will be a fee increase for services within the credentialing program.

The fees will be as follows:

Assessment of Educational Credentials and Qualifications:	\$780
Prior Learning and Recognition (PLAR):	\$425
Preliminary Assessment:	\$300
Returned cheques / declined credit cards:	\$ 75
