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Comments noted by examiners include the following:

- Station 4T: Good explanation to the client; demonstrated technique repeatedly until client was able to perform correctly; good performance.
- Station 5T: Demonstrated good listening skills; corrected the client's technique after incorrect performance.
- Station 7T: Did not pay enough attention to safety precautions.
- Station 8T: Did not gather enough information from client during history taking.
- Station 9C: Attempted an inappropriate exercise with client; subsequently advised client not to perform this exercise.

In reviewing the stations that you failed, we noted the following:

- Precautions of treatment were absent or you completed them incorrectly in Station 7T.
- You did not demonstrate key components of physical assessment or you completed them incorrectly in Station 2T.
- You did not demonstrate key physical techniques or you completed them incorrectly in Station 15C.
- Key components of instructions to client (for performance of techniques in the station) were absent or you completed them incorrectly in Stations 2T, 3T and 15C.
- Components of client self care education (for self-management of the condition) were absent or you completed them incorrectly in Stations 3T and 15C.
