

Role of the examiner

The role of the physiotherapist examiner in the Clinical Component is to observe the performance of the candidate in a clinical station, record the observations on a standardized test sheet, and make a decision about whether the performance in that station is satisfactory or unsatisfactory.

Some physiotherapist examiners are assigned to marking written station answer sheets. They compare the candidate's written answers to an answer key, record the marks and indicate whether the answers are satisfactory or unsatisfactory.

The examiner does not decide whether a candidate passes or fails a station or the exam. Pass/fail decisions are made by the Board of Examiners following the administration of the examination.
